November

Registration - check the Academic Calendar and Orion for specific dates.

Spring Semester

February, March

Check degree plan/audit, make an appointment (as needed) to meet with your advisor.

April

Registration - check the Academic Calendar & Orion for specific dates.

Freshmen

Must register for classes with an advisor.

Sophomore

Register online.

Consider and prepare for study abroad.

Junior

75 hr audits required.

General core courses should be completed.

Have all transfer credits sent to the Registrar's Office.

Senior

Complete Graduation Application before Academic Calendar due date.

- Find registration, add/drop, and payment dates and deadlines.

Registration

- If you are sophomore or above, register online through Orion!
- If you are a freshman or have to register with an advisor, be sure to make an appointment.
- Make out a tentative class schedule before you meet with your advisor to register; be sure to include second and third course choices.

Course Look up tips

- Use the Core Curriculum box to scroll down and find Core classes for such requirements as: Science, Math, Humanities, Social & Behavioral Science and Visual & Performing Arts.
Course Lookup will automatically select "Open" classes as the default.

Advanced vs. Upper Level Elective

- Advanced Elective - 3000 or 4000 level course outside of your major.
- Upper Level Elective - 3000 or 4000 level course, can be within, or outside of your major.

Related Courses

- A&H, LIT, HIST, & AP Majors*
A related course must be within the School of Arts & Humanities, but outside of your major.

AP credit

- You decide if you want to apply credit based on the scores you receive.

Transfer Credits

- If you have credits to transfer, make sure they are sent to the Registrar's Office.
- If you are thinking about taking a class, fill out a Credit Pre-approval form with your advisor.

24/30 Rule

- Once you are within 30 hrs of graduation and have taken here at UTD, this leaves 6 hrs that you can take at another institution.

Degree Audits

- Remember you are responsible for knowing your degree requirements, however...
- Stop by and see your advisor at least once a semester to be on the right track.
- Students with 75 credit hrs accumulated must see their advisor before registration per Registrar's policy.

Degree Plan Changes

You will be locked into the catalog year and degree plan you began taking classes at UTD.

Teacher Certification

- All Teacher Certification students should see their certification advisor in Teacher Development (once a semester or call for updates (972-883-2730)).

Change of Major

- Looking to change your major? Meet with your advisor.

Minors

- You can minor in almost anything; typically, the minor is not included in your major. Check the UTD website or your advisor for details on minors.
