Tim Redman



Dr. Tim Redman, a University of Texas at Dallas professor of literary studies, has been elected to the eight-member executive board of the United States Chess Federation. He served on the USCF board from 1978 to 1985, including three years as president of that organization, which is the governing body for American chess and represents the United States in the World Chess Federation. Dr. Redman directs the chess program at UTD; the school's team became the National Collegiate Chess League's U.S. college chess team champion after an undefeated season. The league, created by Dr. Redman, features top college teams playing over the Internet. UTD offers scholarships to outstanding chess players.
