## **UTD to Host Scholastic Chess Tourney**

RICHARDSON, Texas (September 2, 1999) – Chess players from kindergarten through high school may enter the Fall Scholastic Chess Championships to be held on the campus of The University of Texas at Dallas on Saturday, September 18.

The tournament will be sponsored by the Dallas Area Chess in Schools Foundation and will be run by the Dallas Chess Club. It will be held in the Galaxy Room in the Student Union on the UTD campus, located near the intersection of Campbell and Floyd roads in Richardson.

The competition will give youngsters an opportunity to hone their chess skills and at the same time will encourage membership in the United States Chess Federation, according to Dr. Tim Redman, director of UTD's chess program and newly-elected member of the USCF executive board. The USCF, with 86,000 members, is the governing body for chess in the U.S. and represents this country in the World Chess Federation.

Entry fees for the tournament are as follows: \$5 for USCF members or new USCF members under the age of 15; \$10 for renewing USCF members under the age of 15; \$15 for new or renewing USCF members between the ages of 15 and 19. New and renewing members will receive a one-year USCF membership with their entry.
