

SCHOLARSHIPS

There are a limited number of scholarships available only to General Studies students. For information, inquire at the General Studies Office, GR 2.232. There are three merit based and merit/need based scholarships available from the School of General Studies:

HENRY DUBOIS SCHOLARSHIP
CAROLYN GALERSTEIN SCHOLARSHIP
CAROLYN GALERSTEIN INTERNSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

The eligibility requirements are:

1. The applicant must be a student in American Studies, Gender Studies, or Interdisciplinary Studies. Applicants new to UTD must be accepted into these programs.
2. Applicants must have successfully completed a minimum of six hours at UTD and have attained at least a 3.0 grade point average.
3. Recipients must enroll for at least nine hours during the semester in which they receive the scholarship. Six hours are sufficient during the summer semester or if the recipient is a single head of household employed full time.
4. Recipients will be eligible, upon reapplication, for a renewal of scholarship, as long as they continue to enroll for nine hours each regular semester and maintain satisfactory academic progress. Renewal, however, will be contingent upon the availability of funds.

If you wish to apply:

1. Obtain the specific scholarship application from the General Studies offices (GR 2.232 or GR 2.238)
2. The application requests that you provide a brief personal history and explain your educational goals, career goals, academic background, financial circumstances, and provide two letters of recommendation.

Recipients will be selected on the basis of academic ability and financial circumstances, without regard to race, color, national origin, age, or gender. Submit all materials to the Office of the Dean, The School of General Studies (Green 2.242)

Other University wide scholarships such as the Study Abroad/International Education Scholarship, the Alumni Scholarship, the Selden Leavell Scholarship, the Delores Tucker Scholarship, the UTD Recycling Scholarship and the Amelia Lundell Textbook Scholarship are open to the UTD community. Application packages are available through the Financial Aid Office located in Karl Hoblitzelle Hall.
