

Electives and Credit/No Credit Grading

The four degrees in the School of General Studies include from 24 to 30 hours of unrestricted electives. You may choose these from among any of the undergraduate courses. You may, of course, take electives for grade credit, but they are the only courses that may be taken on a credit/non-credit basis in the program. (An exception to this rule is a course that is offered only on a credit/no credit basis. Such a course may be put into the appropriate Foundations, Concentrations and/or Option Areas.) To take an elective on a credit/no credit basis, you must file a form in the Record's Office by Census Day of the semester in which you take the course.
