

GRADUATE SCHOOL

Many graduate programs such as Law, Medicine, Dentistry, the MBA, do not require a particular disciplinary major for admission, but may require or prefer that students have had specific courses or a specified number of hours in the field of graduate study. If you decide early on that you intend to apply for a particular graduate degree program, you should find out what course work the graduate program requires. This can be done on-line, or by writing or visiting the graduate department for admissions information. Once you have that information, your Advisor can help you incorporate some or all of the undergraduate requirements into your IS degree plan.
