

**Retaking Courses**

A student may repeat a course any number of times to improve the grade in the course. The grade from the first repeat will replace the original grade to satisfy degree requirements, and for calculation of the GPA. Any further repeats will be used in the calculation of a student's GPA, but the course will still only count once for credit toward the degree. All grades will appear on a student's transcript. To repeat a course, the student must fill in a Repeated Course Adjustment Form in the Records Office. Courses for which transfer credit is given cannot be taken a second time for credit at UTD, unless the student wishes to refuse the transfer credit. **If a student fails a course at UTD, the course must be re-taken at UTD.**
