## Historical Sketch

William M. Leary was born in Newark, New Jersey in 1934. He served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War, and was stationed at Kadena, Japan where he worked in operations. His duties included filing flight plans, logging arrivals and departures, and arranging parking and service for transient aircraft. After leaving the Air Force, he received his doctorate in American History at Princeton University.

He then taught at Princeton University, San Diego University, and The University of Victoria (Canada) before joining the faculty at The University of Georgia at Athens where he worked for thirty-two years. In addition to teaching history, he authored several books and articles on the history of aviation. Dr. Leary retired from UGA in 2005 as the E. Merton Coulter Professor of History.

The aviation books Dr. Leary authored covered a variety of aviation topics. He coauthored a book with Leonard A. LeSchack titled *Project Coldfeet*, a book about a covert operation to recover intelligence from an abandoned Soviet weather station. He also wrote histories on the commercial airline industry as well as on airlines, one of which is about Mohawk Airlines. Other topics include articles and books on instrument flying, the Icing Research Tunnel, and a work about Allen Dulles.

Because of his scholarly works on aviation history, Dr. Leary won several awards including the Central Intelligence Agency's Studies in Intelligence Award in 1995, four Fulbright grants, and held the Charles A. Lindbergh Chair in Aerospace History at the National Air and Space Museum, 1996-1997.

According to Dr. Leary, while stationed at Kadena, he noticed an occasional Civil Air Transport aircraft arrive. These aircraft were "handled by an odd group of civilians who inhabited a far corner of the airfield." These strange aircraft and men sparked a curiosity that eventually grew into a historical interest. The result was the beginning of a trilogy of books on the history of aviation in Asia.

The first volume of the trilogy is a book titled *The Dragon's Wings: the Story of the China National Aviation Corporation (CNAC)*. Leary's second volume of the trilogy is *Perilous Missions: Civil Air Transport and CIA Covert Operations in Asia*, a history of Civil Air Transport. His final volume was to be a history of Air America, but sadly, he passed away on 24 February 2006 before he could write the book.

## **Series Description**

The William Leary Papers are arranged in thirteen series:

### **Series I. Air America, 1946-1994. 17 Linear Feet (38 boxes).**

The materials in this series document the history of Civil Air Transport and Air America. Boxes one to four are in chronological order; boxes five through twelve are in alphabetical order with the folder headings bearing the names of Civil Air Transport and Air America personnel. Materials are in the form of photocopies, photographs, articles, manuscript drafts, taped audio interviews, and artifacts.

### **Series II. Operation Coldfeet, 1962-2001. .4 Linear Feet (1 box).**

Materials in this series include photographs and research material used by Dr. Leary.

### **Series III. Allen Dulles, 1893-1969. .8 Linear Feet (2 boxes).**

Materials in this series are arranged chronologically include diary excerpts, copies of correspondence, articles, and chapter drafts. Some topics include Guatemala, Bay of Pigs, and the U2 Incident.

### **Series IV. Air Mail, 1918-1986. 3.75 Linear Feet (9 boxes).**

Arranged chronology, materials include journal articles, newspaper clippings, copies of original correspondence, flight logs, reports, board of inquiry proceedings, congressional hearings, night flying documents, statistics, operational summaries, and photographs.

### **Series V. NASA Icing Research Tunnel (IRT), 1943-2000. 4.5 Linear Feet (8 boxes).**

Part of this series is arranged chronologically and part alphabetically by name. Materials include photographs, reports, articles, specific test program information, technical notes, correspondence, articles, an outline by Dr. Leary, bibliography on microfiche, and NACA-NASA technical papers.

### **Series VI. Instruments, 1918-1987. 2.1 Linear Feet (5 boxes).**

This series is arranged chronologically in part. Materials included in this series are articles, newspaper clippings, correspondence, information on Lawrence Sperry, interview transcripts, and photographs.

### **Series VII. Mohawk Airlines, 1948-1972. 3.4 Linear Feet (7 boxes).**

Box 1, folders 5 through 13 are arranged chronologically, box 4, folders 1 through 4 contain the company newsletter arranged chronologically starting in 1950 and ending in 1970. Material in this collection includes articles, correspondence, annual reports, personnel rosters, statistics, letter books, photographs, and accident investigation reports.

### **Series VIII. Airlines, 1929-Present. .4 Linear Feet (1 box).**

Arranged alphabetically by airline, this series composes mainly photographs or photocopies of photographs. Subjects in photographs include aircraft and personnel. In

folder 24, there is a copy of a finding aid for the Pan American World Airways, Inc. Records located at The University of Miami.

**Series IX. Aviation Personalities. .2 Linear Feet (One-half box).**

Arranged alphabetically with unidentified people in folder 6. The material in this series is made up of primarily photographs, but there are newspaper articles, a biographical chronology of Charles A. Lindbergh, history of Pan American and Juan Trippe, and historical information on Howard Hughes. Note: This series and Series X share the same box.

**Series X. Aircraft, 1918-1930. .2 Linear Feet (One-half box).**

Arranged alphabetically, this series contains primarily photographs, but there is some technical data on the Grumman Goose and an article on Henry Ford and aeronautics written by Dr. Leary. Note: This series and Series IX share the same box.

**Series XI. Bernt Balchen, 1943-1998. .8 Linear Feet (2 boxes).**

Materials in this collection includes personal history in the forms of DD214 documents, accession records for the Balchen Records at the National Archives, a manuscript on Balchen's life written by his wife, correspondence, written works by Balchen, official documents on Project Carpetbagger, cold weather operations, and photographs.

**Series XII. General Research Material. .4 Linear Feet (1 box).**

Material in this series includes information on WWII aircraft production, articles on WWII in the Pacific, air safety, aircraft, and photographs and maps on U.S. Navy submarine under ice operations.

**Series XIII. Negatives. .2 Linear Feet (1 box).**

This box contains negatives from the other series in the collection. Documents Removed sheets are in the appropriate folders directing the researcher to the needed folder. Most of the negatives have corresponding prints. One folder contains microfiche from Series V, IRT, and a microfilm reel from Series I, Air America.

**Scope and Content Note**

The collection contains research material collected by Dr. William Leary during the process of writing books and articles on aviation subjects. The works reflected in this collection cover *Operation Coldfeet*, Allen Dulles, Air Mail, the NASA Icing Research Tunnel, Instrument flying, Mohawk Airlines, Airlines, Aviation Personalities, Aircraft, cold weather flying expert Bernt Balchen, an unfinished work on Air America, and general research material.

Included in the collection are taped interviews, interview transcripts, copies of official government documents, correspondence, articles, newspaper clippings, photographs, negatives, microfiche, accident investigation reports, and NASA technical papers.

The William Leary Papers are arranged in thirteen series contained in seventy-six boxes totaling seventeen linear feet. The Air America series is the largest series

comprising 38 boxes, fifty percent of the collection. Items removed were duplicate items and those of a personal nature not pertinent to the collection.
