Scope and Content Note

The Walther Aschoff Series is arranged in five subseries, which are composed of photographs and postcards from 1911-1940, correspondence from Walther Aschoff to his parents from March 12, 1915 until September 2, 1937, correspondence from individuals to the Aschoff Family from February 1887 until March 1938, and correspondence from individuals to Walther Aschoff from September 6, 1910 until April 16, 1938, memorabilia, tour guides, documents, and a book: *Londonflüge 1917. Der Kampf des ersten Englandgeschwaders. Aus dem Fliegetagebuch von Walter Aschoff*, Potsdam, Ludwig Voggenreiter Verlag, 1940. The letters and postcards are written in Old German Script, the language is German. A transliteration and translation is available.

Series Description

Series I.

Walther Aschoff

Subseries I. Photographs and postcards, 1911-1940, 3.2 linear feet.

The items in box 1 are arranged by date and in box 2 by subject.

Subseries II. Correspondence, 1878-1937, 0.4 linear feet.

The correspondence is arranged in chronological order and within this order divided by correspondence from individuals to the Aschoff Family and to other recipients, correspondence to Walther Aschoff, and correspondence from Walther Aschoff to his parents.

Subseries III. Memorabilia, tour guides and documents, 0.4 linear feet.

The items are arranged by subject. The memorabilia are composed of a scrapbook from Walther's sister Edith Aschoff, war money, and war bonds. The documents are composed of business cards, loose diary pages, newsletter, envelopes, charts, hotel information, handwritten notes, letterhead, and clippings.

Subseries IV. Transliteration and translation of correspondence from Walther Aschoff to his parents, 0.4 linear feet.

Both transliteration and translation of Walther Aschoff's correspondence to his parents is arranged chronologically with the originals. An alphabetical index contains names, locations, and keywords with dates from the letters. The topics covered are trench warfare, personal experiences with war and its atrocities, aviation, training as an observer and bomber crew member, sorties, aerial combat, air-raids, personal political comments, xenophobic remarks about enemy and North Africans serving in French army, casualties, personal reason for participation in war and decision to join flying forces as well as comments about parents' and other family members' situation and contents of parcels being sent to Walther and his demands of nourishment and clothing.
