Historical Sketch

George H. Williams, Jr. was born in Frost, Texas on April 7, 1915. Shortly thereafter his family moved to Waco, Texas where he attended Sanger Avenue Jr. High and Waco High School, graduating in 1933. From 1934 to 1939 he attended Baylor University where he graduated with a BA in Business. From 1939 to 1941 he worked for Hodell and Company, a Houston, Texas area mortgage firm.

In 1941, George Williams enlisted in the United States Army Air Corps, where he attended Officer Candidate School and radio and signals training at Harvard University. Upon completion of training he was assigned as a Signal Officer to the 94th Signal Battalion, based at Camp Crowder, Missouri in 1942. His unit was sent to Europe and played a part in General Patton's relief of American forces trapped at Bastogne, during The Battle of the Bulge, in 1944. His unit remained in Europe repairing communication wires and telephone lines in Germany and France until late 1945. After returning to the United States at the end of the War he remained active in the Army Reserve until the 1950s.

Back in Dallas, George Williams took a job as an executive with the mortgage division of Equitable Life Insurance Corporation. He also continued his interest in researching and collecting information about World War I aviation. He was involved with both the League World War I Aviation Historians, and its journal, *Over the Front*, as well as *Cross and Cockade* and several other aviation societies. He also worked with the History of Aviation Collection at The University of Texas at Dallas, helping it acquire the World War I material collection of A.E. Ferko, as well as numerous other World War I collections. He also taught a World War I history class at The University of Texas at Dallas in the late 1970s, and in 1988 he organized a World War I aviation seminar at the History of Aviation Collection that brought together 125 aviation scholars, as well as the only three surviving American Aces of World War I. Williams continued to volunteer his time and effort at the History of Aviation Collection well into his 80s. He also donated his own, extensive collection of World War I documents and photographs to the History of Aviation Collection.

George Williams married his wife Ginny on May 27, 1933. They had three children; Holly (born 1944), Kay (born 1949), and Scott (born 1955). Williams passed away on June 15, 2006 at the age of 91.

The *George H. Williams, Jr. Collection* is arranged into ten series

Series I: Entente (Allied) Powers. 14.5 linear feet

29 boxes. This series is arranged into four sub-series. Each subseries focuses on information related to the air forces of country's that made up the Entente Powers during World War I.

Subseries I: France. .5 linear feet.

1 box. This subseries is arranged alphabetically. It contains information about French squadrons, units, pilots, aircraft, and military activities during World War I.

Subseries II: Italy. .5 linear feet.

1 box. This subseries is arranged alphabetically. It includes information about Italian squadrons, units, pilots, aircraft, and military activities during World War I.

Subseries III: The United Kingdom and Dominions (Includes Australia and Canada). 11 linear feet.

22 boxes. This subseries is arranged numerically by squadron number. It consists of information about United Kingdom (including Australian and Canadian) squadrons, units, pilots, aircraft, and military activities during World War I.

Subseries IV: The United States of America. 2.5 linear feet.

5 boxes. This subseries is arranged numerically by squadron number. It contains information about American squadrons, units, pilots, aircraft, and military activities during World War I.

Series II: Central Powers. 4.5 linear feet.

9 boxes. This series is arranged into two subseries. Each subseries focuses on information related to the air forces of countries that were members of The Central Powers during World War I.

Subseries I: Austro-Hungary. .5 linear feet.

1 box. This subseries is arranged alphabetically. It contains information about Austro-Hungarian squadrons, units, pilots, aircraft, and military activities during World War I.

Subseries II: Germany. 4 linear feet.

8 boxes. This subseries is arranged numerically by Jagdstaffel (Jasta) number. It contains information about German squadrons, units, pilots, aircraft, and military activities during World War I.

Series III: Biographies. 2.5 linear feet.

5 boxes. This series is arranged alphabetically by subject's country, then alphabetically by last name. Includes biographical information about World War I aviators.

Series IV: Magazines, Journals, and Organizations. 1.5 linear feet.

3 boxes. This series is arranged alphabetically by magazine or organization title. It contains various publications and organizations about World War I aviation.

Series V: George Williams World War I History Class. .5 linear feet.

1 box. This series is arranged topically. It consists of material used by George Williams in presenting a class on World War I aviation at The University of Texas at Dallas.

Series VI: World War I Aviation Topics. 1.5 linear feet.

3 boxes. This series is arranged topically. It consists of information about topics related to World War I aviation.

Series VII: George Williams Correspondence. 1.5 linear feet.

3 boxes. This series is arranged alphabetically by correspondent's last name. Includes correspondence between George Williams and other World War I researchers and scholars.

Series VIII: World War I Multimedia. 9.5 linear feet.

26 boxes. This series is arranged into three subseries. Each subseries contains information in a different form of media.

Subseries I: Audio Tapes. 4.5 linear feet.

9 boxes. This subseries maintained the original order of audio tapes created by George Williams. It includes both standard cassette tapes and reel to reel tapes.

Subseries II: Video Tapes. 2.5 linear feet.

5 boxes. This subseries maintained the original order of video tapes created by George Williams. It contains VHS videotapes about World War I and aviation.

Subseries III: Microfilm. 2.5 linear feet.

12 boxes. This subseries is arranged according to the numbering assigned to the sets of microfilm in this collection. It contains microfilm rolls with data about World War I, including a copy of *The Gorrell History of the American Expeditionary Forces Air Service*.

Series IX: Photographs. 5 linear feet.

10 boxes. This series is arranged into six subseries. Each subseries contains photographs of a specific country's air forces in World War I.

Subseries I: The Entente Powers. 4 linear feet.

8 boxes. This subseries is arranged numerically by squadron number. It contains photographs of French, Italian, British, Australian, Canadian, and American aviation in World War I.

Subseries II: The Central Powers. 1.5 linear feet.

3 boxes. This subseries is arranged numerically by Jasta (squadron) number. It contains photographs of Austro Hungarian and German aviation in World War I.

Subseries III: Other Aviation Photographs. 1 linear foot.

2 boxes. This subseries is arranged topically. It consists of photographs not related to any of the other subseries in this series.

Series X: Oversize Materials. 3 linear feet.

2 boxes. This series is arranged by size. This series includes materials too large to fit in the standard size boxes used throughout the rest of the collection.

Scope and Content

The *George H. Williams, Jr. Collection* is organized into ten series of material:

Series I: Entente (Allied) Powers – 29 Boxes (1912 – 2000)

This series contains documents and photographs related to World War I aviation activities performed by the Entente Powers. It is divided into 4 subseries.

Subseries I: France – 1 Box (1914 – 1975)

This subseries houses combat reports, squadron records, and histories, army reports, photographs and summaries of French Aviation in World War I.

Subseries II: Italy – 1 Box (1915 – 1978)

This series includes documents, squadron histories, casualty and victory lists, and discussions of Italian aviation and the Italian front in World War I.

Subseries III: The United Kingdom (Includes Australia and Canada) – 22 Boxes (1912 – 1999)

This series consists of squadron histories, victory lists, photographs, and discussions of the aviation activities of the United Kingdom and its dominions in World War I.

Subseries IV: The United States of America – 5 boxes (1912 - 2000)

This series contains squadron histories, victory lists, photographs, and discussions of the aviation activities of the United States of America in World War I.

Series II: Central Powers – 9 boxes (1914 – 1978)

This series contains documents and photographs related to World War I aviation activities performed by the Central Powers. It is divided into 2 subseries.

Subseries I: Austro-Hungary – 1 Box (1916 – 1978)

This subseries includes documents, bibliographies, and histories of Austro-Hungarian aviation in World War I.

Subseries II: Germany – 8 Boxes (1914 – 1961)

This subseries contains documents, squadron histories, victory and casualty lists, photographs, and histories of German aviation in World War I.

Series III: Biographies – 5 Boxes (1917 – 1992)

This series includes biographies, articles, diaries, photographs, and personal materials of World War I pilots.

Series IV: Magazines, Journals, and Organizations – 3 Boxes (1918 – 1988)

This series consists of articles, magazine issues, organizational documents, membership information, and other information pertaining to various World War I historian organizations and magazines. It includes information about the League of World War I Aviation Historians, its magazine *Over the Front*, as well as *Cross and Cockade* and *Cross and Cockade International*.

Series V: George Williams History Class – UTD – 1 Box (1979)

This series includes notes, slides, and information used by George Williams in teaching a class on World War I aviation at the University of Texas at Dallas in 1979.

Series VI: World War I Aviation Topics – 3 Boxes (1916 – 1993)

This series contains information about various World War I aviation topics including observation balloons, Texas air fields, training bases, aircraft blueprints, model making, and research projects.

Series VII: George Williams Correspondence – 3 Boxes (1972 – 1976)

This series consists of correspondence between George Williams and various aviation figures, scholars, authors, and writers.

Series VIII: World War I Multimedia – 26 Boxes (1915 – 1993)

This series includes audio tapes, video tapes, and microfilm reels. It is divided in to two subseries.

Subseries I: Audio Tapes – 9 Boxes (1915 – 1991)

This subseries contains audio tapes (both cassette and reel to reel) of interviews with various World War I personalities.

Subseries II: Video Tapes – 5 Boxes (1930 - 1993)

This subseries includes VHS video tapes of documentaries and theatrical films related to World War I and aviation.

Subseries III: Microfilm – 12 Boxes (1915 - 1991)

This subseries contains microfilm of RAF and French air force World War I documents. It also contains a copy of *The Gorrell History of the American Expeditionary Forces Air Service*. Due to the specialized nature of finding information in these microfilms, a separate guide with instruction on how to use the films has been produced. Please consult it for more detailed information on these microfilms.

Series IX: Photographs – 13 Boxes (1903 – 1992)

This series consists of photographs of various pilots, aircraft, and locations in Europe and America. It is divided into three subseries.

Subseries I: The Entente Powers – 1 Box (1915 - 1919)

This subseries contains photographs of French, Italian, British (Australian and Canadian), and American aviators and aircraft.

Subseries II: The Central Powers – 3 Boxes (1917 - 1918)

This subseries consist of photographs of Austro-Hungarian and German aviators and aircraft.

Subseries III: Other Aviation Photographs – 2 Boxes (1917 – 1919)

This subseries includes photographs of various aircraft, aviation personalities, cockpits and components, locations, and other items related to World War I aviation.

Series X: Oversize Materials – 2 Boxes (1914 – 1988)

This series contains oversized items including long play records, large newspapers, aircraft prints, and other items too big to fit in other parts of the collection.
