### **ABOUT THE McDERMOTT LIBRARY FRIENDS**

The McDermott Library Friends is a group of community members, UTD faculty, students, alumni, staff and others who support the Eugene C. McDermott Library. Its goals are to enrich the intellectual and cultural environment for faculty, students and community by promoting excellence in library collections and services, attracting distinguished special collections and sponsoring special events. The Friends group is an advocacy organization that elevates public awareness of and raises funds for UTD Libraries. Members of the Friends help to purchase unique collections and essential equipment, enhance services and other programs for our patrons, and ensure the recruitment and retention of outstanding library staff. Members encourage the use of the McDermott Library as an important source for research and scholarship. As part of a public institution, the McDermott Library must rely upon private funding to ensure continuing enhancement of its collections, services and facilities beyond the minimal level provided for by the State of Texas.

Contributors of \$100 or more qualify for a VIP Card that provides access to some library services. VIP Friends are able to check out five books at a time and use most of the library's databases, e-journals and e-books in-house. There is a Community Computer in the Information Commons near the Reference Desk on the 2nd floor designated for use by the Friends and the public. The card does not include laptop checkout, media checkout, software application, hard copy printing, Internet access, remote computer access, interlibrary loan and TexShare privileges. Patrons can save information to a compact disc, e-mail data to their personal account, use a printer for an additional fee or manually record information. Newly added to the service area is a library print card that can be purchased to use a printer for hard copies.
