¹⁰⁰ Townview Center Wins Team Trophy At DISD Chess Championship

Townview Center won the team first place trophy at the fifth annual Dallas ISD High School Chess Championship held Feb. 2, while Skyline High School student Eduardo Ramos won first place in the individual chess tournament competition with a perfect score of 6-0. The event was sponsored by The University of Texas at Dallas and held at W.T. White High School.

Second to fifth place finishes had identical scores of 5-1; however the tiebreak system placed Jose Montelongo, (Yvonne A. Ewell Townview Center) as second; Francisco Mata (W.W. Samuell High School), as third; Robert Sanchez (Townview Center), as fourth; and Joseph Zuniga (North Dallas High School), as fifth. Townview Center won the team first place trophy

with a total of 15.0 points; Skyline High School placed second place team with 14.5 points; and North Dallas placed third with 13.0 points.

Individual tournament winner, Eduardo Ramos was awarded a 4-year academic Excellence Distinction Scholarship to The University of Texas at Dallas by Dean of Undergraduate Education, Dr. J. Michael Coleman. The UTD scholarship covers cost of tuition and mandatory fees through eight semesters (4 years) of enrollment.

In addition, the Academic Distinction Scholarship provides a \$1,000 per year contribution toward rental expenses incurred at the Waterview Park student apartment complex for students who choose to live on campus.
