



International Education Fund (IEFS) Scholarship

General Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in one of the UTD courses involving study abroad or enrolled in a study abroad program that transfers credit back to UTD.
- You are required to register for at least six (6) semester credit hours for Fall / Spring and at least three (3) semester credit hours for Summer.
- Degree seeking, Non-Degree Seeking and Undeclared Major students may apply.
- Enrolled at least half-time with UTD at the time of application.
- Undergraduate students must have a 2.0 or higher GPA.
- Graduate students must have a 3.0 or higher GPA.
- Satisfaction of institutional protocol through the Office of International Education
- Submit a complete application packet: scholarship application, recommendation letters, cost addendum, cost documentation & narrative.

Completed packets must be returned to the Office of International Education by 4:30 P.M. on/prior to deadline date. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Deadline Dates:

Summer 2012 — March 30, 2012

Fall 2012 — May 29, 2012

Scholarship decisions may take 3-6 weeks after posted deadline. Notification of results will be sent through student's UT Dallas e-mail account.

International Education Fund Scholarship (IEFS)

General Conditions

All students applying for the scholarship must have successfully completed at UT Dallas at least 30 credit hours as an undergraduate student or at least 9 credit hours as a graduate student. Enrolled in one of the UT Dallas courses involving study abroad or enrolled in a study abroad program that transfers credit back to UT Dallas. Degree seeking, non-degree seeking, and undeclared major students may apply. Enrolled at least half-time with UT Dallas at the time of the IEFS application. Undergraduate students must have a 2.0 or higher GPA. Graduate students must have a 3.0 or higher GPA. IEFS eligibility and conditions may be found at <http://www.utdallas.edu/oie/si.htm>. **Only COMPLETE** applications received by the Office of International Education prior to/on the posted deadline will be considered. Applicant will receive decision notification electronically (**only UTD e-mail account**).

Application must include:

1. This scholarship application, completed in full with signature.
2. Two **CURRENT UTD FACULTY** and /or **UTD ACADEMIC ADVISOR** letters of recommendation on UT Dallas letterhead, with original signature, and title. Letters from family members, friends, employers, and clergy will not meet this requirement. Letters from non-UTD faculty are not acceptable.
3. Personal narrative as indicated on this scholarship application.
4. Satisfaction of institutional protocol through the Office of International Education.
