Statement of Understanding

- I understand that it is my responsibility to determine if I am eligible for the H-1B Cap-Gap Extension.
- I understand that my F-1 status and work authorization will automatically be extended if my H-1B application is filed, waitlisted, receipted or approved.
- I understand that if my H-1B application is withdrawn or denied my OPT authorization ends 10 days after the date of withdrawal or denial and my grace period ends 60 days after the date of the withdrawal or denial.
- I understand that in order to maintain F-1 status during my H-1B Cap-Gap Extension I must not be unemployed for more than an aggregate of 90 days
- I understand that during my H-1B Cap-Gap Extension I must report any change of legal name, residential or mailing address, employer name, employer address, and/or loss of employment to the ISSO
- I understand that SEVP strongly recommends that students do not travel outside the United States during the Cap-Gap Extension.
