All applicants applying for this scholarship must be full time UT Dallas undergraduate students majoring in science, math or engineering and be either a graduate of the Nano Explorers Program or actively involved in research or programming with the MacDiarmid Nano Tech Institute. Each applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from the Director of the Institute or a faculty member from math, science or engineering. The scholarship fund will be awarded on a competitive basis by a committee of faculty members duly appointed by the Dean of the School of Natural Sciences and Mathematics. Financial need may be considered. The committee will weigh such factors as: educational achievement, work experience, community service, extracurricular activities and surmounting obstacles in the pursuit of higher education. The recipient must be a US citizen or permanent resident, or a student who has lived in Texas for at least part of their high school experience.

Application MUST Include:

1. This scholarship application, completed in full with signature.
2. A one page narrative.
3. An unofficial transcript.
4. Letter of recommendation from the Director of the Alan G. MacDiarmid NanoTech Institute.
5. Letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the student’s department (science, math, or engineering).

Other Considerations:

1. Must be either a graduate of the Nano Explorers Programs or be actively involved in research or programming with the Alan G. MacDiarmid Nano Tech Institute.

Only COMPLETE applications received by the posted deadline will be considered. Applicant will receive decision notification by email.
