

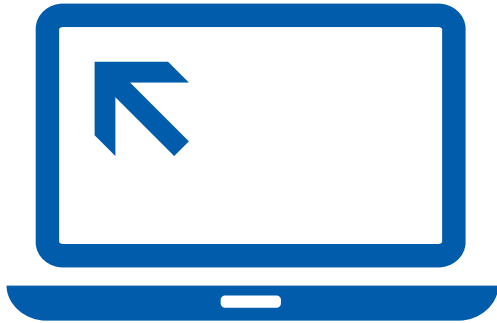

General Information

How soon may I apply for a license?

After residing in Texas at least 30 days you may apply at any Texas DPS license office. Students with unexpired licenses from other states are exempt from the 30-day requirement.

Document Checklist

Proof of identity

- Passport
- Social Security Card/SSN

Proof of lawful presence

- US visa
- Most recent I-20
- Most recent I-94

Proof of residency (bring 2)

- Rental contract
- Pre-printed checks
- Bank statements
- Insurance policies

Vehicle road test

- Current registration + vehicle safety sticker
- Front and back license plate

Vehicle liability insurance

If you do not own a car, you will be required to sign and swear to a statement that you do not own a vehicle. This exempts you from the Texas vehicle registration and liability requirements. You will still need to provide a vehicle for the driving test.



While At The DMV

1. Fill out the application form.
2. Submit your documents.
3. Pass the vision test.
4. Pass the writing and knowledge test.
5. Recieve your learner's permit or take your driving test.

Applying For A State ID

Do I need a driver's license to apply for a State Identification Document?

You may apply for a State Identification Document without a driver's license.
