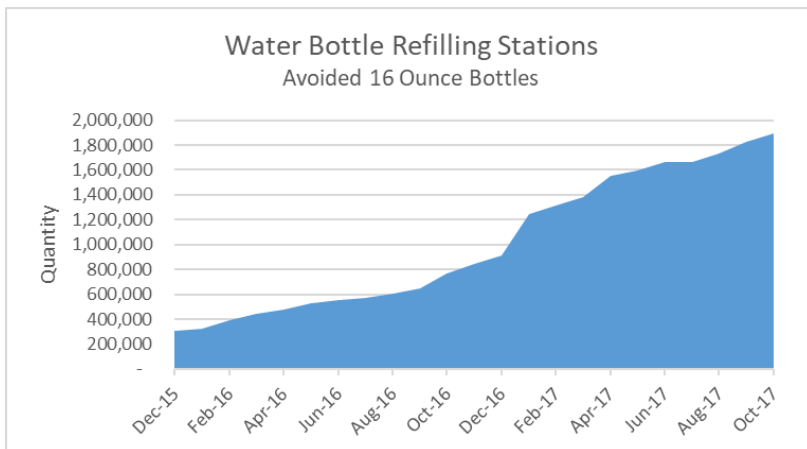

- Minutes Approval
 - Minutes approved.
 - There was no objection.

- Facilities Management / Sustainability Office
 - Texas Recycles Day
 - This will take place on November 15th
 - The Office of Sustainability will be coordinating with various offices and departments to collect and recycle Styrofoam #6 and Plastic Film.
 - Tree Campus USA Recertification
 - The Office of Sustainability is in the process of gathering information to submit a recertification application for Tree Campus USA.
 - The Arbor Day Texas Planting event was part of the Arbor Day observance that is included in the standards for certification.
 - Over 25 volunteers planted 22 trees on-campus.

 - RecycleMania Planning
 - The Office of Sustainability has submitted the online registration form for UT Dallas to participate in 2018's RecycleMania.
 - RecycleMania will take place from January to April 1st of 2018
 - A spreadsheet is being generated to track trash, recycling, and food waste.
 - Student Government may have interest in hosting events, activities, and/or other initiatives to raise awareness of recycling on-campus.
 - There was discussion on housing competitions. This included potentially a "House Cup" winner and/or having live or weekly updates of which campus housing buildings have contributed the most recycling to the recycling dumpsters.

- There was interest in promoting confidential paper shredding during RecycleMania to encourage staff and faculty to clean out their offices and storage rooms.

 - Earth Week Planning
 - An early draft of April 2018's Earth Week calendar was provided on the agenda.
 - This included an Earth Fair, documentary showing, a volunteer activity, and a garden workday and potluck.
 - There was discussion on having a faculty member lead/facilitate a short 5-10-minute discussion on the documentary subject.
 - There is interest in having a faculty panel on sustainability related research.
 - To maximize attendance, partnering with the Office of Research was discussed as they would be able to assist in promoting the event.
 - Eco-Rep (Kelsey Lyle) has a meeting coming up with an organization involved with virtual reality.
 - The meeting will be to discuss what opportunities exist for an event during Earth Week that links a virtual reality experience to sustainability.
 - There is interest in a native plant scavenger hunt.
- Discussion
 - Two more water bottle refilling stations have been added at the Canyon Creek Housing locations.
 - There are a total of 36 stations throughout campus.
 - Usage of the water bottle refilling station has resulted in over 1.89 million 16-ounce water bottles avoided from the landfill since inception.
 - Three additional sustainability related courses have been pursued by faculty to integrate into the course inventory offered at UT Dallas.
 - There is interest in having the Eco-Reps provide a demonstration of how to construct and manage a small-scale vermicomposting bin.
 - During Viva Volunteer 2017, about 20 student volunteers participated in planting trees at the Community Garden and pull weeds at the Monarch Waystation.
