- Minutes Approval
 - Minutes approved.
 - There was no objection.
 - Minutes are posted on the sustainability website.

- Facilities Management/Sustainability Office
 - RecycleMania Partnerships
 - We are currently participating in RecycleMania, an international recycling competition. It ends on April 1.
 - We have formed new partnerships this year with Dining Services and Athletics.
 - Dining Services is sponsoring a promotion that includes a free bottle of water with the recycling of 10 aluminum cans and/or plastic bottles. These must be brought to the Papa Johns, SU Outtakes, or JSOM Coffee Corner locations to be reviewed by the cashier and placed in designated recycle bins.
 - Athletics will be accommodating the Sustainability Office and Eco Reps during the February 15 basketball game, which includes tabling, a halftime activity focused on recycling (recycle-relay), and announcement.
 - Intercom has published a blurb on recycling and RecycleMania late January.
 - There is interest in further marketing of RecycleMania and recycling using social media tools.
 - SU Dining area napkin dispensers include RecycleMania messages on them.

 - Recycling Bin Grant
 - UT Dallas was awarded a Coca Cola Foundation Recycling Bin Grant.
 - This includes 25, 60 gallon, blue-recycling bins.
 - Expected delivery of the bins is in March.
 - Requirements of the grant entail a publication and tracking of the materials.

- Tree Campus USA
 - The recertification application was submitted before the winter break.
 - We are currently waiting on the Arbor Day Foundation to send the email confirming our designation as Tree Campus USA 2017.
 - Per requirement of Tree Campus USA, we will be having a speaker 1x per semester at the committee meetings to talk about tree management at UT Dallas.
- Eco Rep Projects
 - The Eco-Reps/Sustainability Interns are working on a number of projects this semester.
 - RecycleMania projects include data collection and management, social media marketing and graphic design, and supporting & participating in partnership activities.
 - Other projects include Earth Week planning, support recycling operations and outreach, sustainability social media graphic development, and working to spread the sustainability message throughout campus.
- Past Events
 - None
- Future Events
 - Butterfly Flutterby
 - There will be a butterfly Flutterby event on February 26 from 9 AM to 11 AM.
 - TRACS Summit @ Tarleton State University
 - There will be a summit at Tarleton State University on March 27 to 29.
 - This summit will include workshops, speakers, and presentations related to sustainability and conservation.
 - Earth Week
 - Earth Week will be taking place from April 16 to 21.
 - The current schedule is on the back of the agenda.
 - A more up-to-date schedule will be provided at the next committee meeting.
 - Dr. Reichert and Dr. Gelb are looking into recruiting professors who can speak at the faculty research panel.
- Discussion (around the table)
 - Recycling Scholarship
 - There is a recycling scholarship at UT Dallas for students.
 - The cardboard recycling program managed by Facilities Management funds the scholarship.
 - Discussion took place to determine if there is interest in communicating with the Financial Aid or Development Office to integrate a sustainability-oriented requirement for the scholarship applicants.
 - More updates on the scholarships will be included at the next meeting.
 - Textile Recycling Opportunity
 - The World Wear Project offers textile (clothing, hats, shoes, purse, etc.) recycling at no cost.
 - The Sustainability Office is working with Housing to see if a bin may be placed near the residence halls or university village.
 - More updates will be available at the next meeting.

- Student Government Green Initiative
 - The Student Government has allotted \$8,000 toward green projects.
 - Students will have the opportunity to submit project proposals.
 - Student Government is putting together an ad-hoc committee to manage the project application and advertising process.
 - More updates will be available at the next meeting.
- There have been student requests for composting bins at housing.
 - Direct future requests to Evan and he will reach out to Housing to see if there is interest in hosting a compost bin.
- There was discussion on the university strategic plan and if sustainability would have a place within the plan.
 - A presentation was presented to the President's Cabinet on Monday, February 5, 2018 to highlight the growing popularity of sustainability at UT Dallas and available programs and activities.
 - In the presentation, it was noted that integrating sustainability into the strategic plan is of interest.
- The interviews for the new Sustainability Manager (Official: Associate Director of Energy Conservation and Sustainability) are currently taking place in February.
- Starbucks offers a reusable cup for students, staff, and faculty at UT Dallas. Using the reusable cups will award the users a discounted drink.
 - There is interest in helping promote this through social media.
- There was discussion on new, compostable Keurig pod options.
- There was discussion on future possibilities of integrating sustainability into academic programs.
