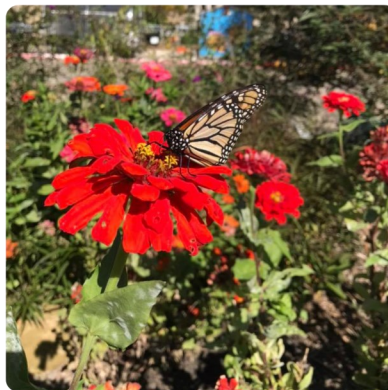

100+ pounds of peppers were harvested throughout the semester

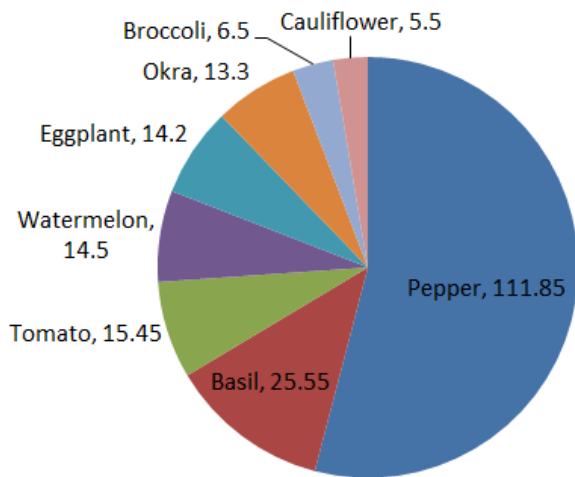


The pollinator garden provided respite for monarchs during their southward migration



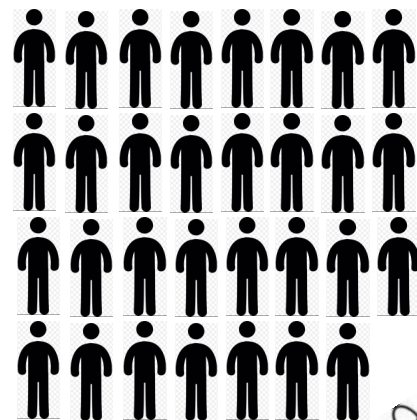
Gardeners assembled hoop houses to protect plants from winter precipitation
